Jamesville-DeWitt Career Alternative Program

The Jamesville-DeWitt High School offers a program to students who exhibit strong tendencies toward becoming drop-outs from the system. Students who have been unsuccessful in school settings – failing one or more years and unable to cope with the School’s normal operating procedures, may become part of the Career Alternative Program (C.A.P.). This program provides each student with an individualized course of study, which lists the steps necessary for graduation. With this detailed plan found in the administrative handbook and the support of the C.A.P. faculty and staff, students can begin to see graduation as a realistic possibility.
