

Selection Criteria for NYS Scholarships for Academic Excellence

Jamesville-DeWitt High School will use the following criteria to determine the nominees for the NYS Scholarships for Academic Excellence:

A Weighted average of the scores on the following Regents examinations will be determined:

Comprehensive English – weight of three

Algebra 2 & Trigonometry – weight of three

Global Studies – weight of one

US History/Government – weight of one

Science- Earth Science, Biology & Chemistry – weight of one for each course

The student with the highest average will be nominated for the \$1500 scholarship, and the students with the next four highest averages will each be nominated for a \$500 scholarship.

In order to use the benefits of the scholarship, the winner must be in attendance as a full-time, matriculated student at an approved NYS postsecondary institution by the Fall 2014 semester. Winners who enroll at an out-of-state institution in the Fall 2014 are not eligible and forfeit the award.
