

Registering with the NCAA

To play a Division I or Division II sport at the collegiate level, you must register with the NCAA.

Students should register with the Eligibility Center at the beginning of their junior year in high school. At the end of the student's junior year, a transcript, which includes six semesters of grades, will be sent to the Eligibility Center from the high school. Additionally, students should have their SAT or ACT scores forwarded directly to the Eligibility Center (by using code "9999") whenever they take the exam. If an exam has already been taken, students must send scores to the Eligibility Center by contacting ACT (www.actstudent.org) or SAT (www.collegeboard.com) directly. Test scores on a transcript cannot be used.

To register online you will need to do the following:

During your junior year (or senior year), register at the NCAA Eligibility Center's Website at:

Follow their instructions.

IMPORTANT FINAL STEP – Print the **Transcript Release Form**, sign it, and bring it to the Counseling Center secretary. Your preliminary transcript and final transcript will then be forwarded to the NCAA.
