Earth Science Lab will be held on **August 9th and/or 10th

- All students taking the Earth Science Regents Exam **MUST** also participate in the August Performance Assessment (Lab Practical).
- Students who arrive more than 45 minutes after the start of the exam are not eligible to take the exam
- All students will need to **provide documentation of their identity** prior to being seated for any exam. Identification must be in the form of:
 - Valid picture ID (Driver's license, student ID, Sheriff's ID, Passport) OR
 - A test taker ID form - this must be obtained from the home district
- Students must bring proper items for exam(s) in which they are taking (including but not limited to):
 - Black Pens
 - Pencils
 - Calculator (basic, graphic or scientific)
 - Ruler
 - Compass (Geometry Common Core)
- Electronic devices will be collected prior to the start of the exam.

- Students **MUST** register with their home school counselor
- Registration **WILL NOT** take place on site
- Registration ends on June 27th at noon
- Late registration ends on July 3rd at noon
- Regents only registration ends July 20th at noon
- Schedules will be available online by June 29th
- Enrollment and staff availability determine when courses will be offered
- Classes that don't meet enrollment criteria will not run
- To be enrolled in one of our repeat courses a student must have already completed the course (including all labs for science courses)
- Some districts have a minimum grade and attendance requirement

Policies & Procedures

Attendance Policy

OCM BOCES Board of Education revised the Summer School attendance policy. Please note below the policy. Students are expected to attend scheduled classes and be present for the entire class period. A student who is absent receives a zero grade for participation and a zero grade for performance for that day and significantly reduces his/her chances of earning a passing grade for the course. **There is no distinction between excused and unexcused absences. No missed work/tests can be made up.**

26 Day Course: Students absent more than six (6) school days will be dismissed from summer school.

13 Day Course: Students absent more than two (2) school days will be dismissed from summer school.

Two instances of tardiness/early dismissal under 15 minutes will be counted as one (1) absence. Each tardy/early dismissal over 15 minutes will be counted as one absence.

Final Average/Course Credit

BOCES will provide districts with student summer school performance data (marking period grades, final exam grade, Regents grade, attendance and discipline data). Districts will use summer school data and possibly their data from the school year to determine student final averages. Districts will determine if credit will be awarded. The home school will make the determination whether a student passes or fails and will award credit accordingly; **BOCES does not calculate final averages nor award credit.**

Transportation

Please contact the students home district's transportation office regarding the location and times for student pick-up and drop-off. If told that the district does not provide transportation, the parent and/or student is then responsible for transportation to/from summer school. Students should arrive no earlier than **ten** minutes before their first class begins and be picked up no later than **ten** minutes after their last class ends.
