

Driving to School

Students are *not permitted* to drive motor vehicles to school without permission from the administration. *Only seniors and juniors who are academically eligible and in good standing regarding discipline* are allowed to drive on a regular basis. Permission forms should be obtained from the Assistant Principal, completed and returned, before a student drives to school. No sophomore or freshman will be given permission to drive. Exceptions will only be made for in-season extra-curricular activities and then only those that are Jamesville-DeWitt High School sponsored. **Only students in possession of exhibited valid permits are permitted to park on campus. All others will be sent home.**

Students will be eligible for a driving permit upon completion of the *Alive at 25* Driver Awareness Program and/or a certified driver education program. Students must successfully complete the program before being issued a driving permit.

Student Driving Guidelines and Consequences

- **Student Drivers who do not maintain a passing grade in all registered courses:**
 - Will have their driving privileges suspended until the next semester.

- **Student Drivers who exceed three illegal lates or absences in one semester:**
 - May have their driving privileges suspended for the remainder of the semester.

- **Leaving school grounds without permission:**
 - May result in student driving privileges being suspended for the remainder of the semester:

- **Exchanging or allowing another student to use your parking sticker without administrative permission:**
 - Automatic Suspension of Driving Privileges

- **Parking in the wrong parking section without administrative permission:**
 - First offense – warning
 - Second offense – Driving privileges may be suspended

- **Seniors who transport underclassmen off campus during lunch or school hours:**
 - Will have their driving privileges suspended for the remainder of the semester.

Student drivers please be advised that these guidelines are in addition to the behavior code, and are designed to reinforce academics, attendance and citizenship.
