We are so excited for September to arrive and to begin our school year! Kindergarten is filled with lots of learning and fun! It will be a very busy, exciting and productive school year!


As you begin to get ready for Kindergarten, we ask that you send in the following supplies either during “Sneak Peek” or on the first day of school:

Dear 4th Grade Families,

When you begin thinking about "Back to School" shopping, these guidelines may be helpful.

Need to have:

1. Four sturdy 2-pocket folders
