**Superintendent's Report**

Dr. Kendrick reported that the school year is off to a great start with an uneventful opening day of school. She shared that enrollment, as of the date of the Board Meeting, has fairly stabilized. At this point there is no recommendation to add more classrooms at the elementary schools. Current enrollment for the District is slightly down from last year, mostly at the elementary school level. Dr. Kendrick reported that a family came to register that had been displaced by the hurricane in Florida. We will register the students that meet the criteria and support this effort to provide relief. She shared the district's success on the AP tests that were administered last May. We have seen an increase in our

students taking AP Level courses and these students are performing well. Jamesville-DeWitt had 49 AP Scholars, 23 Scholars with Honor, 35 Scholars with Distinction and 3 National AP Scholars. Dr. Kendrick spoke about the Countywide Shared Services Plan, on which the vote will take place Wednesday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. The recommendation that would impact J-D directly is the proposal that OCM BOCES serves as an organization to develop a hub to transport non-public students as well as some students with disabilities. The plan would service school districts in Onondaga County. Dr. Kendrick reminded the Board of upcoming opening events as well as some of the past week. Last week Moses Dewitt had their Welcome Back Ice Cream Social and the Middle School had their 5<sup>th</sup> grade Welcome Back Picnic where families had the opportunity to interact informally.

### **Board President's Report**

Mr. Schulman reported on his and Mrs. Murphy's attendance at the recent CNYSBA Board President's Roundtable at Drumlins. CNYSBA is moving and will have a new address as of January 1, 2018. Mr. Schulman reported on a husband and wife team of Professors from SUNY Cortland that spoke. They spoke about the large number of teachers expected to retire in the next five years, as well as a declining number of education majors graduating from college, many of which are leaving New York State. Mr. Schulman spoke about how to address a "leadership pipeline" where schools and universities help teachers get involved in administrative programs so that school districts can hire from within. Dr. Kendrick reported that we have administrative interns regularly through a collaborative connection with Syracuse University, through the Teaching Center. Mr. Schulman addressed the use of cell phones during board meetings.

### **Community Comment**

Mr. Schulman asked for community comments; there were none.

### **Unfinished and Continuing Business**

Mr. Van Schaick reported that he had been to the PTG Meeting at the Middle School. Mr. Van Schaick also had a question as to our Comprehensive Building and Safety Plan and what our obligation would be in the event that our buildings would need to be used as shelters, such as in the hurricanes in Houston and Florida. Dr. Kendrick advised that in terms of sheltering others, the American Red Cross reaches out locally and that during a major catastrophe we would provide what we can. Plans for regional preparedness are developed through the local municipality.

Mrs. Murphy complimented Jason Crawford, Director of Facilities and the Buildings and Grounds staff on the beautiful job they did getting the campus ready for the start of school.

At 7:30 p.m., Mrs. Kielbasinski moved, Mrs. Murphy seconded, the meeting be adjourned to executive session.
