**SUBJECT:** School Calendar and School Day

## **School Calendar**

Under Education Law, the minimum number of instructional days in a school year is 180 days. The law provides that some of these days can be used for Superintendent conference days. The dates that school is in session and that personnel must report for duty are ultimately the responsibility of the Board of Education.

A school calendar shall be developed annually by the Superintendent and submitted to the Board of Education for approval and/or amendment prior to the end of the current school year.

## **School Day**

The school day shall be set by the Superintendent with approval of the Board.
