Dr. Smith welcomed Ms. Ashley Carducci to Jamesville-DeWitt and Tecumseh Elementary School. She is bringing a wealth of knowledge and enthusiasm to this leadership role.

Approve Substitute Pay Rates

Approve Increase in School Lunch Prices

Dr. Smith and Mr. Decker shared information on the School Lunch Program. The District Food Service Manager, Rita Vedsted has recommended the District continue with the free meal program for 21-22 school year. In addition, in the event that the SSO program is discontinued, a recommendation for the following price increases was made:

Breakfast at all schools from \$2.00 to \$2.10 Lunch at High School from \$3.25 to \$3.40, Lunch at Middle School from \$3.10 to \$3.15 Lunch at Elementary School from \$2.90 to \$3.00

Mrs. Austin moved and Mr. Zoghby seconded the approval of the increase in School Lunch Prices. (See Supplemental Minutes).

Potential Consideration for Future Meetings

Mrs. DeForest reviewed some of the topics on the list of Potential Consideration for Future Meetings including Universal Pre-K and sidewalks. Dr. Archer asked about consideration for accessibility to Lyndon Fields.

Discussion for Board Members Attending Remotely

Mrs. DeForest shared a Board Policy with members, which states if a Board Member can be seen and heard, then they may vote but the alternate location must be made public on the agenda. There was a discussion among the Board. Ms. McKenney said that we should continue to make the meetings accessible. Mr. Gross asked for clarification from the policy committee if attending remotely counts as attendance. Dr. Smith said a legal opinion might be necessary to see whether or not a Board member can attend without the obligation of a being Board member.

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Smith provided the Board with an enrollment update, which he said is relatively unchanged since last discussion. He said Kindergarten numbers in all the buildings have gone up and he is comfortable with numbers of sections assigned to grade levels. Dr. Smith provided a construction update with pictures. Dr. Smith also updated the Board with regard to the Request for Proposals for Pre-K which were sent out to a number of preschool operators. Lastly, Dr. Smith shared that administrators met for two days for their annual retreat. At the retreat they reviewed the work completed during the 2020-21 school year and developed plans to continue moving forward.

Discipline Report

Mr. Reyes presented the Board with the Annual Student Conduct & Discipline Report. (See Supplemental Minutes). The presentation covered trends in code of conduct violations, supports for students, factors in improving and maintaining a positive school climate, and future plans. There was Board discussion on the report and Mr. Reyes will provide follow-up.

President's Report

Mrs. DeForest thanked the Board for their input on committee assignments. She thanked the following Board members for volunteering to chair the following committees: Mr. Gross, Audit; Dr. Archer, Finance; Mrs. James Murad, Policy; and Mr. Leach, Facilities. She said she would email assignments to Board members and they will be on the website as well. She said the meetings are subject to open meetings law and she will be working with the chairs to post the meetings ahead of time. She said any Board member not on the committee, may attend but as an observer only. Mrs. DeForest also spoke about the use of a consent agenda. She explained that typical agenda items which we don't anticipate discussion on can be approved all in one motion. Lastly, Mrs. DeForest discussed the August Board of Education retreat and asked for feedback from the Board. She gave examples of what has been done in the past. Dr. Archer suggested the Strategic Plan with emphasis on diversity, equity and inclusion. Ms. McKenney suggested information on Special Education and experiences of parents of children with special needs.
