Edda Kassis commented in favor of an SRO and said the district and community need to continue to work together.

Katie Rybinski commented in favor of an SRO and said that an SRO is the first line of defense for students and staff.

Amy Kallander commented against an SRO and said no statistics support placing SRO's in schools.

Cecilia Blackwood commented against an SRO and said students of color are not being treated equitably.

Rachel Wagner commented that she is concerned about the focus on an SRO when there are many other safety concerns.

Max Mimaroglu commented that student input should be considered and students should be made aware of Board meetings.

At 6:50 p.m. Dr. Corcoran moved and Mrs. James Murad seconded the Public Hearing be adjourned.
